- 1. request your rent history,
- 2. file for a rent reduction for lack services /repairs or
- 3. file for a complaint if you believe you being overcharged your rent stabilized apartment

First Option: You can access your rent history by email, to rentinfo@nyshcr.org . The rent history will be printed and mailed directly to the apartment/building address.

Second Option: Call the Rent Infoline at 718-739-6400. The rent history will be mailed directly to the apartment/building address.

Third Option: Visit a Borough/District Rent Office in person. The Brooklyn Borough Rent Office is located at: 55 Hanson Place, Room 702 Brooklyn, NY 11217. Phone: 718-722-4778.

When visiting, please bring proof of identity (photo ID) and proof of tenancy (copy of lease, rent receipt or utility bill). You can get will be required to complete an Access to Records form and the rent history will be printed and given to you at the office.

Forth Option: Mail an Access to Records form to the attention of "Records Access Officer" at Gertz Plaza, 92-31 Union Hall Street Jamaica, New York 11433 or by email to orafoil@nyshcr.org. You must include proof of tenancy (see above). The rent history will be printed and mailed to you.
